



The Founding Spirit: Mother Brigida Morello's Legacy

other Brigida Morello was born on June 17, 1610, in St. Michele di Pagana, near Rapallo, Italy, to Nicolo Morello and Lavinia Borzese. She was the sixth of eleven children, nurtured in a devout family that cherished education, faith, and community service. Her parents instilled in their children a strong sense of duty, love for God, and devotion to the Virgin Mary. From a young age, Brigida felt an profound connection with God, aspiring to dedicate her life to Him. Although she initially envisioned a life of holiness and religious service, God's plan led her to marriage.

In 1633, Brigida married Mathew Zancari in Rapallo. However, their happiness was short-lived due to illness during the siege, and Mathew's untimely death from tuberculosis in 1639. After his passing, Brigida renewed her commitment to God, taking a vow of perpetual chastity and consecrating herself to Jesus Christ.

On February 17, 1649, Brigida founded the Ursuline Congregation in Piacenza, Italy, with a mission to provide value-based education to young girls, preparing them to become exemplary wives and mothers. The congregation flourished, spreading across Europe, Asia, and South America. Today, the daughters of Mother Brigida Morello continue her legacy of education and service in various mission fields, including Italy, India, and Brazil.

Students from our school participated in the Warbits Artificial Intelligence event held at DR Rizvi Learners on October 28, 2024, and were awarded certificates for their participation.










Dopamine & Serotonin: The happiness transmitters


Do you know what your happiness sounds like in vivo? It's called dopamine and serotonin; these are chemical neurotransmitters pivotal in transmitting signals to the brain and body, resulting in neurotic behavior control. Dopamine(C8H11NO2), also known as a 'feel good' chemical, is synthesized via tyrosine and regulates motivation and pleasure. Whereas Serotonin(C10H12N2O), also known as the 'happiness hormone', regulates mood, sleep, appetite, and digestion, and is synthesized with the help of tryptophan.

In the delicate ballet of our neural symphony, dopamine pirouettes along the brain's reward circuits, choreographing movements that direct our desires and ambitions. Produced from the amino acid tyrosine, it is converted to L-DOPA, then to dopamine, each step catalysed by an enzyme such as tyrosine hydroxylase and aromatic amino acid decarboxylase. This cascade powers our quest for pleasure, learning, and memory, weaving experiences into the fabric of our consciousness.

Conversely, serotonin, referred to as the 'happiness hormone,' is born out of tryptophan, an indispensable amino acid derived from our diet. Through hydroxylation and decarboxylation in the brain's raphe nuclei, tryptophan gives birth to serotonin, which later spreads to control mood, sleep, hunger, and digestion. The control of this neurotransmitter spreads beyond the brain, into the gut and blood platelets, highlighting its central role in both mental and bodily health.

Their deficiency causes depression, anxiety, OCD, sleep disorders, and bipolar disorders. SSRIs (Selective Serotonin Reuptake Inhibitors) block the reuptake of serotonin in neurons and leave some amount of serotonin in our brain to improve our mood.

The Role of Chemistry in Understanding Finding and Curing Diseases

Chemistry plays a crucial role in understanding diseases by providing the basis for comprehending biochemical pathways involved in disease processes. Biochemistry is essential in this regard, as it helps identify and characterize pathogens, explaining how they infect hosts. Additionally, organic chemistry aids in developing drugs that target specific biochemical pathways in pathogens, thus contributing to the creation of effective treatments.

In the realm of developing diagnostic tools, chemistry enables the creation of biochemical assays that measure biomarkers in the body, such as blood sugar levels or enzyme levels(fig1.1). Analytical chemistry techniques, including mass spectrometry and chromatography, are vital for identifying and quantifying substances in biological samples. Furthermore, chemistry is fundamental to advanced imaging techniques like MRI and PET, which use chemical principles to visualize and diagnose various condition.

In the medical and drug field, chemistry is instrumental through molecular docking, a computational technique used to predict interactions between molecules, such as proteins or enzymes(fig1.2).

Structure-activity relationship (SAR) explore how changes in the chemical structure of a molecule affect its biological activity. Additionally, pharmacokinetics and pharmacodynamics help understand how drugs are absorbed, distributed, metabolized, and excreted in the body, as well as how the interact with their targets safely and effectively.

Discovery learning is used in the classroom during problem solving exercises and educational programs.

The role of teachers in discovery lessons-

The teacher's role in education is always complex, regardless of the subject matter or the age of the students. In general, the main focus is to help learners understand what they already know more deeply and accurately while





strengthening their dispositions to continue learning throughout life.

The challenge of a teacher in discovery learning is to change the students from being consumers of knowledge to producers of knowledge through the explorations they undertake. He becomes a facilitator and shares his skills and knowledge through supporting the students in what they undertaking.

In discovery learning, a teacher must be active by watching and recording how the students are achieving their learning objectives.

The role of teachers is to provide initial information and materials to work on. Another important element for Teachers to ask questions, give guidance encouragement and feedback. The involvement of group can also facilitate the learning process.

Discovery learning enable teachers to teach creativity and help students to think more. The pre-requisite for the success of the strategy lies in teachers first understanding the subject matter by experiencing them through training.

Teachers should also understand what might hamper students from understanding the subject through probing.

Significant contribution of Indian Mathematics

High Medicinal and Therapeutic Value of Holy Plant: Tulsi

The plant of Tulsi is traditionally used for preparation of various Ayurvedic formulations for treatment of asthma, bronchitis, and influenza. The hot concoction of Tulsi leaves is usually provided for immediate relief in cold, cough, sneezing nose, dengue and malaria. The bio-organic constituents of Tulsi extracts shows antioxidant activity, anti-aging, immuno modulatory, anti-inflammatory, anti-stress, hepato protective, radio protective, antihelmintic, repellent and larvicidal activity and healing properties in hepatic injury and gastric ulcer. It also plays a role in modulation of both cellular and humeral immunity.

No doubt Tulsi plant is a good source of natural products mainly phyto-constituents which can be used as alternative medicine for the treatment of various human health problems but proper composition and appropriate formulations is required before being used. The phytochemicals of Tulsi extract such as eugenol, rosmarinic acid, apigenin, myretenal, luteolin, β -sitosterol, and carnosic acid having chemo preventive and radio protective effects for skin, liver, oral, and lung cancers by increasing the antioxidant activity. Unripe fruit extract having eugenol, and methyl eugenol, is found highly effective against a resistant strain of Staphylococcus aureus. It's leaf extract in combination with chloramphenicol and trimethoprim, shows strong antibacterial activity against drug resistant S. enterica serovar.

Antidiabetic activity is reported in tetracyclic triterpenoid [16-hydroxy- 4, 4, 10, 13-tetramethyl-17-(4-methyl-pentyl)-hexadecahydro cyclopenta phenanthren-3-one] isolated from aerial parts. Oleanolic acid is major constituents, which account for many medicinal activities of this plant. Methods have been developed for rapid detection of their oxidation products from Tulsi leaves. These acids are helpful is slow down of cell division and growth creates antiaging-effect.

भारतेन्दु हरिश्चन्द्र जी की उक्त पंक्तियाँ अत्यन्त सारगर्भित हैं। अत्मनिर्भरता, आत्मविश्वास, प्रगति इन सबके बीज हमारी राजभाषा हिन्दी में ही निहित है।

हिन्दी भाषा की उत्पत्ति लगभग 1000 साल पहले हुई थी जो मुख्य रूप से अपभ्रंश भाषा से विकसित हुई है। अपभ्रंश प्राकृत की अंतिम अवस्था है और प्राकृत संस्कृत से विकसित हुई है।

विश्व में तृतीय स्थान पर विराजमान हिन्दी भाषा की स्थित क्या विचारणीय है। क्या अन्य भाषाओं की तुलना में हिन्दी उपेक्षित है। हिन्दी को उपेक्षित नहीं कहा जा सकता है क्योंकि विश्व की 7164 भाषाओं में तृतीय स्थान पर शोभायमान हिन्दी अपना वर्चस्व स्थापित की हुई है। तथापि हिन्दी की स्थिति विचारणीय है। कारण, हिन्दी अपने स्वरूप को खो रही है। संस्कृत से जन्मी हिन्दी में संस्कृत के तत्सम शब्दों की भरमार है। साथ ही अरबी, फारसी और अंग्रेजी शब्दों का भी भण्डार है। जिस समय हिन्दी अस्तित्व में आयी, उस समय भारतवर्ष में मुगलों का पदार्पण हो चुका था। अतः स्वाभाविक है हिन्दी में
